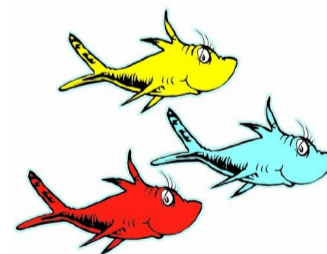

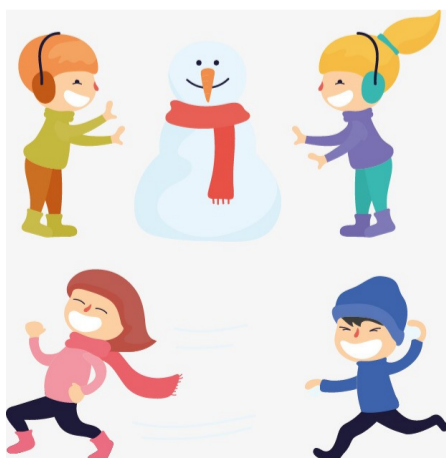
Dates to Remember
