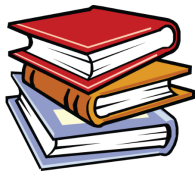
### Good Bye September!!

### Homework

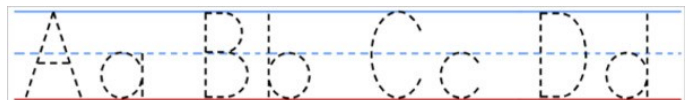
A take home activity will be tracing letters of their name to build on writing skills.
